
### Counselling

Mrs. M. Paul, former Bengali teacher of the Junior Section of Loreto Day School, Dharamtala, was one of those teachers in the school who always smiled, no matter how low she felt, or how stressed she was. She was one of those teachers who taught her students incredible life lessons through simple jokes and laughter. Her words never resonated really deeply the moment she said them, but as we grew older, we realized the depth of them. Mrs. Paul was one of those teachers who made all her students laugh regardless of what her mental state was at that moment. She was someone who could identify her students' problems and weaknesses before they themselves did, and she always made it a point to correct them. Mrs. Paul was one of those teachers who knew just how much pressure her children could take, and when they would burn out. At times, when we were tired and troubled with the pressure of studies, stress and tuitions, she made it a point to give us a free day and would say, "No studies today. Let's just play a game." She would discuss her students' fears before their exams, validate them, and motivate them to give their best.

We have often heard the phrase "School is our second home, and teachers our second mothers." Mrs. Paul was one of those teachers who made her students believe in that phrase.



Who knew that sitting on the floor and studying could be fun? But Mrs. Paul's concept of "Masti Ki Pathshala" made that particular exercise fun for the students. Masti Ki Pathshala was a fun activity where every other week, Mrs. M. Paul made a certain group of students sit on the floor, on a mat, and study in order to get the flavour of how children studied in rural areas. And my God! Were we absolutely DESPERATE for it to be our turn to sit on the floor and study in her period?

Mrs. Paul made us find joy in the simplest of things in life. Just like the concept of "Masti Ki Pathshala". She herself was a very simple human being who only found joy in the laughter of her students and whose smile will forever be etched in all our minds.

The day Mrs. Paul passed away, all of us were devastated. She was one of those rare souls who left a mark on the lives of everyone she met. Her kind words and easy-going nature was easier to embrace than one could ever imagine. Her demise has left a void in all our hearts - a deep wound that is probably beyond repair. It was so sudden that it felt like the angels had swooped her up from among us before any of us even got a chance to notice her absence.

While Mrs. M. Paul might not be physically present among us, she will live on forever in each of our hearts. She will be missed every minute of our lives, but she will always be loved, no matter how old and grey we grow. Loreto Day School, Dharamtala was blessed to have her, albeit for just a few years but she has left an indelible trail behind.




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
